Length	Content	Details
20 sec	Introduction	 Introduce who you are and what business you are from. Give a brief introduction to tune the audience in. Introduce the team and their roles.
30 sec	The Problem	 Introduce the Problem Frame so the judges can see the problem too. Use research and personal situations (if possible) to support the Problem Frame.
45 sec	The Solution	 Present how your team will solve the problem being raised. Introduce you solution, with detail including how it works, examples of what it will do and what a customer would experience so people understand it. Provide case studies to help people if needs be.
45 sec	Demonstration	 Choose to show on of the following: a prototype of your product, 3D walk through of your locations, demonstrate your website, app or service.
20 sec	Key Milestones	 Explain the stages you will complete towards launching the idea, including any trial stages or tests you will complete.
25 sec	Target Customers	 Outline the different target customer groups that you are going to focus upon, outlining the demographic, geographic and behavioural factors of those groups.
25 sec	Current Industry	 Introduce who your potential collaborators and competitors could be. Outline any information you have about the industry and the size of the problem (if possible). Outline your competitive advantage that makes you stand out from the current industry.
35 sec	Financial Forecast	 Briefly outline the financial model for the business, which could include; Establishment Costs and major purchases, Forecast Profit & Loss Statement and any major trends or changes that should be pointed out. Prices you are charging to customers, and how much money you will be making from these transactions, Any other major financial costs. Provide an overview of the Cost-Benefit Analysis to show the impact the solution will make and why it is needed to solve the problem.
20 sec	Support Required	 Ask for the support you need to start the solution (financial support, in-kind, etc.) and who do you believe will give it to you? Will you give the investor or supporter anything in return for their support?
25 sec	Impact / Conclusion	 Remind everyone of the impact this solution will make on the problem. Summarise any other key points, and close out the presentation with a memorable statement. Provide your contact details for any follow up questions.

Requirements
